"Pirkko Home" Ministry news Dima Gusev ("Pirkko Homes" ministry coordinator) gives these updates:



Our summer camp for rehabilitation centers, which took place in the Tver region in July, went well. About 250 people attended. We were pleased that graduates of the rehab centers also came. Speakers were invited who covered the topic of leadership, based on the book of 2nd Chronicles and the example of the kings. Spiritual counseling was organized and carried out by ministers, and it worked well. Lots of friendships were made or renewed, providing times of warm fellowship. We didn't get so lucky with the weather; it was very cold and rainy. But that's what is needed for this type of gathering. If it had been hotter, we would have been all worn

out. It was a great encouragement for all attending, and for the churches of the Tver region.

The **new church plant at Solnechnogorsk** started independent services - it is exciting and scary at the same time, but we are pressing on. At the same time we are working on the church building; the stairs and porch are finished, we are doing finish work on the first floor, and the second floor is almost finished. We also are preparing for moving into the building and working on building relationships with the neighbors and residents of the city.

There is no clarity on the **new law** regarding missionary activity. Everyone is in anticipation. More emotions and fear are going on, than actual facts. We wait and pray that God would keep the rehab centers and churches safe.

Nikulino - The **Markov family** welcomed their newborn daughter, Kristina; mother and daughter are doing well. Restoration work at the rehab center there is continuing (after the fire). Vehicle repairs also need to be done.

Ruchiyok – Right now **Artem and Oksana Panin** are doing fine physically, as well as spiritually. (Artem had lung cancer.) They are among the team members that are forming the new church in Solnechnogorsk.

My health is good. My wife Natasha is awesome, taking care of our four children when I'm away; the children are growing up quickly! God gives her strength, but it's still difficult. God is keeping us all in His hands. Praise Him!
