and testimonies in your magazine touch their hearts. About 40 people attend our prison worship services. This year, 8 sisters were baptized in the IK-4 prison; and this is also to your merit. By your magazine you enter the prison and minister there. Your magazine is simply asked for, read and passed on to others - and in this colony there are about 1000 women. God bless you! I sent you a donation for the magazine for 2018."

## "Liberation" - Pirkko Home Rehab Center Ministry

Andrei (Bavykin) Kholodov, leader of the Pirkko Home in the small city of Kimry, Tver region, shares: "In our ministry, it is normal practice to 'beg of the Lord' on behalf of people. For example, the head of the hospital admissions department, after refusing hospitalization for one of our men, said, 'Leaving him in your center in such a condition, you are taking on an unbearable burden. Why would you do that? What will you do with him?' I replied, 'We'll pray.' And in response I heard another question: 'Yes, and what will your prayers do?' That person does not understand the power of prayer. Andrei P. came to us with frost-bite three months ago. At 31 years old, he was homeless and drank heavily; he had no mother, and his father refused to help him. We took him to the hospital, but they would not take him in. We began to pray and talk about the need, and one Christian nurse responded. She came almost every day to change his dressings. And God cured him - he already is walking, has repented, and works around the Pirkko Home. And this is not an isolated case. Recently the church in Dedovsk asked us to accept another man, who, after his previous time in rehab, left and again stumbled. Because of his drinking, his hand was swollen, but he could not be put in the hospital, because he had no documents. Again we prayed and his hand recovered. Another man, Igor L., after two months of being in the rehab center here, had a stroke. At first his legs refused to move, then his whole body went numb, he stopped speaking, then became like a "vegetable." Doctors refused to help, but God cured this man through prayer. Maybe someone will say: "it's just a coincidence, he would have recovered by himself." But for us it's a miracle! We bring our needs to God in prayer, are strengthened by the Word of God, and firmly believe that the Lord will hear us. Please also pray for us."

Another joyful bit of news: On June 9, Andrei Kholodov is planning to marry Yana from the Tver church.
